Create Your Own Art Making Experience!

Are you looking for a creative and memorable experience to celebrate a birthday, family event, or a girls' weekend away? Call us to plan something today! Enjoy a half-day, full-day, or two-day private art-making experience with an Art Colony instructor.

The event requires a minimum of 5 participants.

Tuition begins at \$50/person for non-members and \$45/person for members. Final cost is dependent upon additional supply fee, length of session, and refreshments.

Fun with Kiln-formed Glass

Explore the world of kiln-formed glass by designing your own unique piece and firing it in one of our kilns. Students will learn to select and cut glass, as well as options for layering and design. Work is fired overnight and groups can pick it up the following day. Options include: sushi dishes, sun catchers, pendants, magnets, coasters, or ornaments.

Tuition: \$50/person for half-day session (3 hours)

Supplies: \$10/person

Kiln Fee: \$10/group of 5; \$20/group of 9

Functional Glass Painting

Join Anna for an opportunity to turn plain glass into personal artwork, conversation pieces, or holiday gifts. In the process, students will learn about the supplies and materials needed to decorate glass, and tips on how to paint images and blend color. Anna will also give instruction on how to make pieces permanent and dishwasher safe.

Tuition: \$50/person for half-day session (3 hours)

Supplies: \$15/person

Relief Printmaking: Cards or Fabric

Learn to carve in linoleum block, and then print a series of cards or decorate a fabric of your choice.

Tuition: \$50/person for half-day session (3 hours)

Supplies: \$15/person

Monoprinting

Learn the painterly method of printmaking by working with a plexi-glass surface to create a unique, one-time print. Students will learn a variety of techniques, what a ghost print is, and how to ink and print their plate. Students will be able to complete up to 5 monoprints in the half-day session.

Tuition: \$50/person for half-day session (3 hours)

Supplies: \$10/person

Screenprinting: T-shirts and Bags

Choose from a variety of pre-selected designs to print onto a T-shirt or bag. Personalized designs will need to be created in conjunction with the artist and include the design fee.

Tuition: \$50/person for half-day session (3 hours)

Supplies: \$20/person or \$10 if bringing own item to print on

Design Fee (if applicable): \$40 one-time fee

Painting: Watercolor or Oil

Whether in the studio or outdoors, painting the North Shore is arguably one of the most satisfying and inspiring ways for artists to interact with the surrounding landscape. Join one of our local painters to go more in depth on your practice or begin at the beginning with a foundational overview.

Tuition: \$50/person for half-day (3 hours)

\$110/person for one-day (6 hours)

\$200/person for two-day (12 hours)

Supplies: \$30/student (may vary depending on medium)

Art Around Town Tour

Tour the various public artworks around town and learn about the rich and on-going history of the arts in Cook County. Included are works by Birney Quick, Byron Bradley, George Morrison, Hazel Belvo, and Betsy Bowen.

Tuition: \$15/person

Bookbinding Studio Tour

Scott Husby

Scott Husby has been a conservation bookbinder since the 1970s, and has worked at the Library of Congress, the Folger Shakespeare Library, the Smithsonian, and also served as the rare books conservator for Princeton University. Participants will have the chance to visit Scott's hand bookbindery and learn about his more than 40-year career. Scott will showcase the tools, equipment, and materials used in making hand-bound books as well as an assortment of historical bookbinding models.

Tuition: \$20/person

REGISTRATION INFORMATION and CANCELLATION POLICY

Interested groups should contact the Art Colony to outline an art-making experience and possible dates. Once groups commit to a date for their event they will put down a \$100 non-refundable deposit, or 50% of the total cost if less than \$100, and sign an agreement form.

- If a group cancels 29 – 8 days in advance of the event start date the Art Colony will retain the non-refundable deposit.
- There will be no refunds given if groups cancel 7 – 0 days in advance of the event.
- If the Art Colony has to cancel an event, groups will be notified immediately and fully reimbursed.
- If an individual participant cancels, making the group number below the minimum, the group is still required to pay the minimum amount for the event.
- If an individual participant cancels, the group has already paid in full, and the group number is still above the minimum, the individual participant will receive the following reimbursement based on the time of cancellation:
 - 30 or more days in advance: 100% of payment refunded, minus a \$5 processing fee
 - 29 – 7 days in advance: half of tuition payment and supply fee is reimbursed
 - 7 – 0 days in advance: no reimbursement
